Celtic Crosses

The Celtic Cross is a symbol of eternity. The circle symbolizes the endlessness of God's love shown through Christ's crucifixion. This cross became a common symbol of Christianity in the 4th century. In the Middle Ages, the cross was erected where an act of violence had been committed, an accident had occurred or in front of farmhouses. Today it is commonly used as a form of gravestones in Ireland.

Orthodox Crosses

Also known as the Pope's cross, the Russian Orthodox cross or the Byzantine cross. It was first used by Byzantine artists. The top bar bears the meaning: "Jesus Christ, King of the Jews." The middle bar is where Christ's hands were nailed and the lower bar has several interpretations. One was to cause discomfort to the victim and another was to represent the robber who was crucified on the right side of Christ and ascended to heaven.

Crucifixes

Near the end of the 6th century, the practice of placing Jesus' figure on the cross began. The image was of triumph with Jesus smiling and open-eyed. It wasn't until the 10th century that they started putting a suffering Christ on the cross. This was not very popular and was considered blasphemy by the Pope. Throughout the next several hundred years, artists began showing the true torment Jesus had suffered by deepening his hand wounds, adding a crown of thorns and showing his dripping blood. They also changed his shroud into a skimpy loincloth.

Four Way Medals

The "Four Medals in One" is also known as a cruciform, which means in the shape of a cross. At the top of the medal is The Sacred Heart (a scapular medal, with Our Lady of Mt. Carmel on the Back);

St. Christopher on the right; St. Joseph on the left and the Miraculous Medal on the bottom. Inscribed on the back of the medal are the words "I am Catholic, please call a priest" which indicate the request for the last sacraments in an emergency.

He kissed St. Anthony and told him how much he loved him. You will often see medals and statues of St. Anthony with the Child in his arms. He is the Franciscan Miracle-worker.

(Carpenters, Church, Doubt, Dying, Engineers, Families, Fathers, Hesitation, Married Couples, Social Justice)

St. Joseph was a carpenter by trade. He was very trusted by God, therefore he was given the important task of becoming the Husband of Mary and the Foster Father of Jesus. He protected Mary on the way to Bethlehem and was present on the first Christmas. He taught Jesus the trade of carpentry. Joseph did not live to see Jesus become great and famous.

He was named Patron Saint of the Universal Church in 1870.

Joseph is the "just and righteous man" and the patron saint of labor and of the dying.
